By joining the **Usisi Amandla Fellowship**, young women will be able to interact with senior public policy analysts, political leaders, government technocrats, regional and global influencers. They will be trained and mentored in public policy to enhance your capacity to influence and change policy. There will be opportunities for peer learning, exposure and further growth like exchange programmes, fellowships and programmes for further studies.

This opportunity is open to young **females below 35 years**; early career to mid-level managers in government and civil society or entrepreneurs involved public policy engagements. Each cohort lasts 1 year.
